PRO REPEAL

Gays have higher incidence of HIV/AIDS

VS

HIV/AIDS is worldwide epidemic, not a gay disease

and

HIV/AIDS is a healthcare issue,
not personnel issue

Open gay service increases exposure for heterosexuals

VS

Military screens recruits for HIV

Added healthcare costs
would burden military healthcare system

VS

Heterosexuals engage in risky behavior

therefore

Gays should not be singled out for exclusion

Open gay service would encourage promiscuity and,
therefore, increase risk of contagion after accession
